Building on the success of the First Edition, the CD-ROMs are the creation of American astronomer and photographer, **Tom Bullock**. Tom has published a number of text books on Astronomy and was formerly the Instructor of Astronomy and Planetarium Director of West Valley College in Saratoga, California. He now works as a freelance photographer.

"I have a passion for travel and photographing the people and places of the world, especially the visually-appealing, remote regions and antiquities associated with them. To spend a few hours alone with the impressive stones of Stonehenge bathed in full moonlight; to wander amongst the mute, hollow-eyed, intricately carved heads of Chile's Easter Island; or just to enjoy the majesty of sunrise behind a California oak; these are the delights that nourish my soul."

The CD-ROMs are not just about the well-known sites. Since taking a year out of his lectureship in 1989 to study them, he has personally visited over 500 ancient sites in the UK, Ireland and Brittany. The CD-ROMs include a complete listing of every stone circle and row known (or suspected) to exist in the British Isles. Detailed maps, based on Ordnance Survey grid references, allow you to search by either geographical region or name. Also included is a survey of stone structures built by other civilisations, and hundreds of QuickTime VR panoramas, videos and stunning new aerial photographs by **JJ Evendon**.

The **Megalithic Portal** companion web site, www.megalithic.co.uk is the ultimate online resource for standing stones and ancient sites. Each page is linked from the CD-ROMs, providing an updated accompaniment so your investment will never be out of date. The Megalithic Portal is the creation of **Andy Burnham**, but over the years since the start in 1996 the project has evolved into a major team effort. Input comes from numerous photographers, archaeologists, visitors and locals, including, we hope, you!

The major aim of the project is to publicise and protect our ancient sites, encouraging visitors to respect them and to play their part in ensuring survival for generations to come. During the last couple of centuries, the pressures of modern agriculture, development and quarrying has led to the destruction of prehistoric monuments on a grand scale.
